From the President:

I always want to be able to deliver good news and positive thoughts to our community members. Unfortunately that is not the case with this newsletter. We have had numerous inquiries and complaints about three registered sex offenders living at 16915 – 161st Street SE, that is division 2 of our community. Several of the area residents have received notification from the Thurston County Sheriff’s office. I am aware that not all community members received this notice. For that reason I feel that the Board of Trustees has the responsibility to notify all members of these recent events. Enclosed with this newsletter you will find all of the information that is available regarding these 3 individuals. We have been in contact with the Thurston County Sheriff’s Office and there is nothing that the Board of Trustees can do about this

situation. The owner of the property attended the last board meeting and answered questions and listened to the concerns of the board and the neighbors. His position is to maintain that house for rental to sexual offenders. The Thurston County Sheriff will, along with the Department of Corrections make themselves available for a community meeting if that is what the community in general would like. They have also stated that as far as they know there is nothing we can do, we cannot discriminate against these people. They tell us that they are monitored by the Sheriff’s department and the Dept. of Corrections, they are supposed to wear GPS, and are closely watched.
